The Presenter

Alessandro Crisi, Psy.D., SPA Fellow, is a licensed psychologist and psychotherapist in Rome, Italy. He is the founder and president of the Italian Wartegg Institute and an Adjunct Professor in the Clinical Psychology Program at the Sapienza University of Rome. For many years, Dr. Crisi has been a consultant to the Rome Institute of Speech Therapy and to the criminal and civil courts in Rome. He also serves on the executive committee of Italian Association for Forensic Psychology. Dr. Crisi is the author of many publications concerning psychological assessment and psychodiagnosis. He presents frequently around the world on psychological assessment and the Wartegg.

Training Overview

This training is dedicated to the Crisi Wartegg System (CWS), a new methodology for the clinical use of the Wartegg Drawing Completion Test (WDCT). The WDCT is a performance-based drawing technique that can be completed in 5-10 minutes by the client and is appropriate for children, adolescents, and adults and even with people with mental disabilities. Once you become competent in its use, the test takes 40-45 minutes to administer, score and interpret. The WDCT is not well known in the United States; however, a recent meta-analysis attests to its validity in assessing personality and psychopathology. It was also recently recognized as a valid performance-based personality test that can be used for certification in Therapeutic Assessment. The process to become certified in the CWS consists of the following steps:

1. Level 1 workshop, three days (16 hours)
2. Level 2 workshop, 4 days (27 hours).
3. Advanced level, 4 days (18 hours)
4. A final exam to obtain certification
5. Optional Advanced training focused on case presentation held in Rome, Italy

The dates for the second and third trainings will be chosen by workshop participants at the end of the Level 1 training.

Fees

The fee for the Level 1 training is \$500. The fees for the Level 2 and Advanced trainings will be \$600 each.

Prerequisite Training

The training is open to mental health professionals and graduate students training to be mental health professionals. Previous knowledge of the Rorschach and other performance-based personality tests is useful.

Objectives

By the end of this **Level 1**, participants will be able to:

- Use the standardized administration procedures with childhood.
- Use the standardized administration procedures with adult.
- Use the CWS in the group administration (Selection and Career Guidance).
- Score the Wartegg protocol (through many practical exercises).
- Compute the Analysis of Sequence 1 and 2.
- Compute all of the CWS Indices.
- Compute the comparison between the Indices of the Adaptive Area and those of the Affective Area.
- Compute the Wartegg Index of Psychopathology (WIP).
- Have a beginning knowledge of the main clinical indices.
- Be familiar with the clinical software available through the IIW of Rome.

Continuing Education

This workshop qualifies for 18 hours of Type I CE credits for psychologists. The Society for Personality Assessment is approved by the American Psychological Association to sponsor continuing education for psychologists. SPA maintains responsibility for the program and its content.
